Good day,

Please be advised that effective September 1, 2024, Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries' (MBLL) Canadian inland carrier will be changing to ASL Distribution Services and Clarke Transport.

ASL Distribution Services and Clarke Transport will take over logistic services beginning September 1, 2024, and in preparation for the carrier changeover the contractor may contact the suppliers prior to September 1st.

Please note the correct contactors for the transition period.

- Purchase orders issued prior to September 1, 2024, will still be transported through Bison Transport.
- Purchase issued on or after September 1, 2024, for Eastern Canada, Ontario, Quebec, and Atlantic Provinces will be handled by Clarke Transport.
- Purchased issued on or after September 1, 2024, for Western Canada, British Columbia, Alberta, and Saskatchewan will be handled by ASL Distribution Services

Please remember there may be local requirements related to specifics location or your delivery requirements that the contractors may not be aware of for the first few deliveries. We are confident that ASL and Clarke will continue to provide excellent customer service, however, we would appreciate your patience as we transition to the new carriers.
